**Contractor/Grantee Responsibilities:**

The Grantee agrees that in consideration of the Owner granting this Right-of-Entry, the affected property will be reasonably restored to its condition preceding their entry.

The Grantee agrees to hold harmless the Owner, its officers and employees, from any claims, damages or losses, including reasonable legal fees, associated with the Grantee's entry and associated work. The Grantee shall be solely responsible for the maintenance of traffic around the work zone, work zone safety and any damages arising from it's activities on said work zone. Grantee shall provide and maintain all appropriate signage, lighting and barricades throughout the duration of the project.

This agreement is terminated upon project completion by signature of the Owner, after inspection.
